ALL THAT BEGINS WELL ENDS WELL



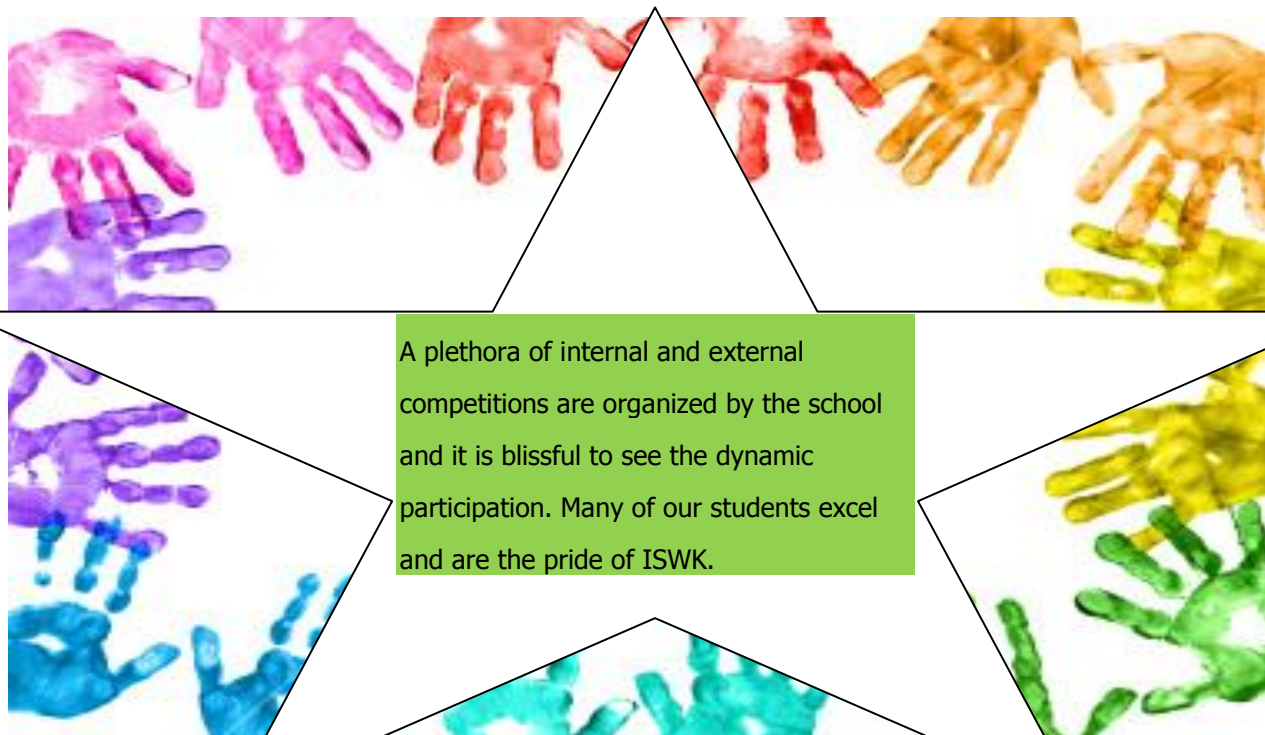

A plethora of internal and external competitions are organized by the school and it is blissful to see the dynamic participation. Many of our students excel and are the pride of ISWK.

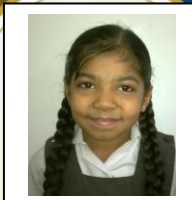
