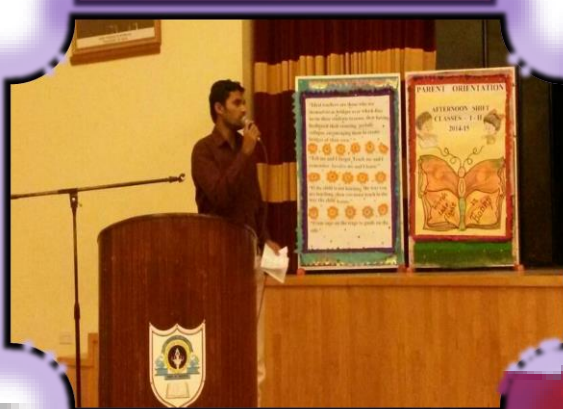




PARENT ORIENTATION
