We look forward to having all our tiny tots on the Nursery campus and assure you that your ward's first experience of learning and growing, will be an enjoyable one.


As we get geared to welcome them, we furnish here a few guidelines and details for your information:

**FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL: MONDAY, 18<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2022 (17<sup>TH</sup> being the Easter holiday)**

**REPORTING TIME: 8:00 a.m.          DISPERSAL TIME: 12:00 noon**

- Please ensure that your ward is dropped and picked up on time. This will give your child a secure feeling.
- They will be in the care of our teachers and the support staff until you pick them up, however, kindly arrange to pick your ward up not later than 12.30 noon.
- Kindly instruct the transporters to accompany your child safely to his vehicle.
- During the initial stages, your child may take a few days to settle, but will soon get acclimatized and enjoy the new, fun-filled environment.
- It is recommended that your child be toilet trained, if not already so. This will ensure that he/she is comfortable at school.
- Please avoid calling or meeting teachers during school hours. Please request for an appointment to meet with the teacher before 8:00 a.m. or after 12:15 p.m.
- Your child should be smartly dressed for school with hair combed neatly, outdoor comfortable clothes and adequate footwear or shoes. (NO SLIPPERS)
- Provide your child with healthy tiffin, water bottle (not feeder) and a school bag, which your child can easily open and close.
- Only healthy food is recommended in his/her snack box: no chips, chocolates or fizzy drinks please.
- It is recommended that your child is weaned away from the Milk bottle or Feeder.
- An extra pair of clothes should be kept separately in a plastic bag for use if and when required. This will need to be carried on all days.
- Fancy trinkets and jewelery are not allowed to school.

- Please label all your child's belongings with his/her name.
  - Kindly check the school bag for circulars and work cards.
  - If your child is sick with running nose/fever or is under medication, please do not send your child to school. If your child develops a fever or feels sick, you will be asked to come and pick your child up. Please keep the Staff Nurse informed of any medical issue if faced by your child.
  - Staff members will greet your child at the entrance. Please bid good byes quickly and leave your child in the caring hands of the teacher. This will settle your child well to begin the day.
  - Important information and timely details will be conveyed to you through circulars.
