We are pleased to share the proud achievements of our students who have brought laurels to Indian School Al Wadi Al Kabir (ISWK) by representing the school at the **CBSE Nationals in Athletics, Boxing, Cricket, and Handball**.

- The ISWK Under-19 Boys' team won the **Silver Medal** in the **4x100m Relay** and the **Bronze Medal** in the **4x400m Relay** at the **CBSE National Athletics Meet**.
- At the CBSE National Boxing Championship, ISWK secured a Bronze Medal in the 56–60 kg (Under-19 Boys) category.
