- 1. SAFAL KSA is a diagnostic assessment aimed at assessing the achievement of competencies by learners. This is neither a competition nor a qualifying/certification exam. The primary purpose of SAFAL is to diagnose the areas where more efforts are required for quality teaching-learning in the school.*
- 2. Since SAFAL is a competency-based assessment, no extra classes or special preparation are required. Competency-focused, learner-centric classroom teaching is sufficient.*
- 3. SAFAL is a tool to assess teaching-learning practices in schools and should be approached in this spirit.*

The syllabus for this exam will be based on the content covered during their time in Grade VIII (2024-25). The assessment will consist of Online MCQ-type questions.
