





HISTORY OF NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY

The history of National Science Day begins with the discovery of the Raman Effect by Sir C.V. Raman in 1928, a breakthrough that earned him the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930. To honor this achievement, the Government of India declared 28th February as National Science Day in 1986, following a proposal by the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC). The first celebration was held in 1987, and since then, the day has been observed annually across the country with lectures, exhibitions, and events that highlight India's scientific achievements and inspire future generations to embrace innovation and research.

About C.V. Raman

Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman was born on 7th November 1888 in Tiruchirappalli, India. He studied physics at Presidency College, Madras, where he excelled academically. Though he began his career in the Indian Finance Department, his passion for science led him into research in optics and acoustics. In 1928, he discovered the Raman Effect, a breakthrough in light scattering, which earned him the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930, making him the first Asian to receive this honor. He later worked at the Indian Institute of Science and founded the Raman Research Institute in Bangalore. Recognized with the Bharat Ratna in 1954, he passed away on 21st November 1970, leaving a lasting legacy in Indian and global science.

Project brief
Our team proudly presents six innovative projects under the title 'ABQWANI'. Aiming towards Al-Nahda, aligning with Oman Vision 2040 and the Net-Zero

2050 goals by transforming waste into valuable resources and promoting eco-friendly materials.
Carbon-Storing Mineral Fibers capture atmospheric CO₂ via mineral carbonation into stable calcium carbonate, forming durable fiber bundles that lock carbon long-term, reducing plastic use and ensuring sustainable consumer goods.

La Sika Sika Packets utilize data waste and Lubex with natural starch to create biodegradable, non-toxic moisture absorbers from organic waste, reducing energy-intensive synthetic silica gels.
Electret Microplastic Filters employ permanently charged polymers—created by heating insulators between high-voltage electrodes—to electrostatically capture microscopic pollutants from water, offering reusable filtration.

SCS Bio-based Production converts used cooking oil through transesterification into drop-in diesel fuel, slashing emissions by 80%, enhancing energy security, and supporting a circular economy.
Shearol Extra Anti-Fungal Paint combines neem extract into water-based paints, eliminating conventional formaldehydes and health risks while preventing mold/fungal/bacterial growth with a safe biodegradable formula.

carbed carbon fibers into compressed, low-cost bricks using mineral PVA, cornstarch, and POP binders, ideal for non-load-bearing interiors, partitions, and desks.
These scalable solutions foster sustainability through innovation, waste valorization, and community impact.

Lessons learnt
Our teamwork on the Oman Sustainability Fair projects taught us the power of diverse skills and open communication in sparking innovation and overcoming hurdles like tight timelines and material costs. By pooling expertise, embracing failures as learning opportunities, and holding regular check-ins, we turned challenges into strengths, building trust and a shared commitment to sustainability goals like Oman Vision 2040.

In such cases, the Transfer Certificate will be issued within 5 working days.


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
