Understanding your child is one of the most important things that one needs to learn as a parent. It is very helpful in becoming effective in guiding and nurturing your child as they grow and mature. There is absolutely nothing wrong with being proud of your children, especially if they are doing so well in school, sports or they are doing so well in school, sports or anything else they have put their interest anything else they have put their interest and into. But, please, parents, be realistic and into. But, please, parents, be realistic and reasonable. There are a lot of ways to reasonable without you are of your children without compromising their reputation, your ego (which you surely take care of so much), or especially your relationship with them. You can just hug your kid and tell him/her how blessed and happy you are to have such a great son/daughter. It is better and means a lot more to him/her.

A child's image of his/her parents depends, among other things, on how the latter see and treat the former. And being on the front lines of a child's growth and development, there is a great chance that kids will see what their parents do and say as always true and correct. If parents treat children as equals-people who think, move, and have a life of their own-and with more consideration to their actual being while still maintaining (and certainly not abusing) their parental authority, then the kids will feel more appreciated and secured. A preschooler knows what he wants to be when he grows up (only that this might more likely change depending on the values and interests he develops and the environment he grows up in). Parents should respect their children's thoughts. It is not because they are younger than adults, who are self-proclaimed mature people, that they should disregard what the youth have to say. Parents should genuinely listen to and understand their children and not impose on them their own thoughts and values.
