

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

## SECTION 5 - Subject-wise NLE Qualifiers



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- SLE Subject Toppers at rank 1, 2 and 3 are awarded With Medals and Rank Certificates.
  - SLE Subject Topper Medals and Rank Certificates are awarded if minimum 10 students participate in that particular subject from a class.
  - SLE Subject Topper MUST score 70% and above to qualify for Medals & Rank Certificates.
- Students who have scored 70% and above have qualified for the National Level Examination (NLE) except Hindi.
- Rest all students are awarded with SLE Participation Certificates.
- School topper is the top performing student scoring the highest aggregate weighted score across all the classes and subjects, student must be registered in at least any two of the five subjects.
- The School Topper is awarded only if the school has subscribed to at least a minimum of 100 tests across all classes and subjects.
- The School topper is awarded with Rs. 1,000/- scholarship, School topper Certificate and the School Topper Medal.
- Orange Education reserves rights to cancel any award or medal or the certificate if the participant is found to have used any unfair means to gain an unfair advantage over the other participants.
