It's a kudos to the enthusiastic participants and the most diligent teachers of ISWK!



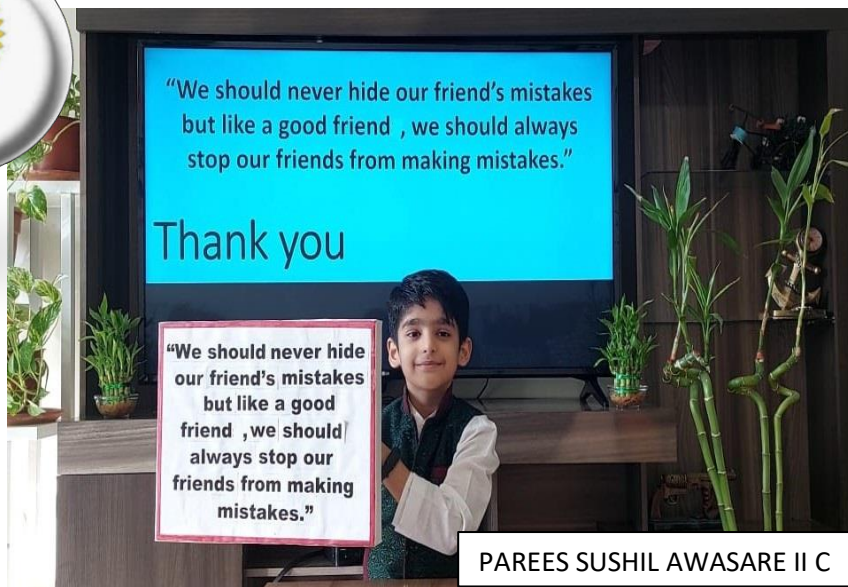

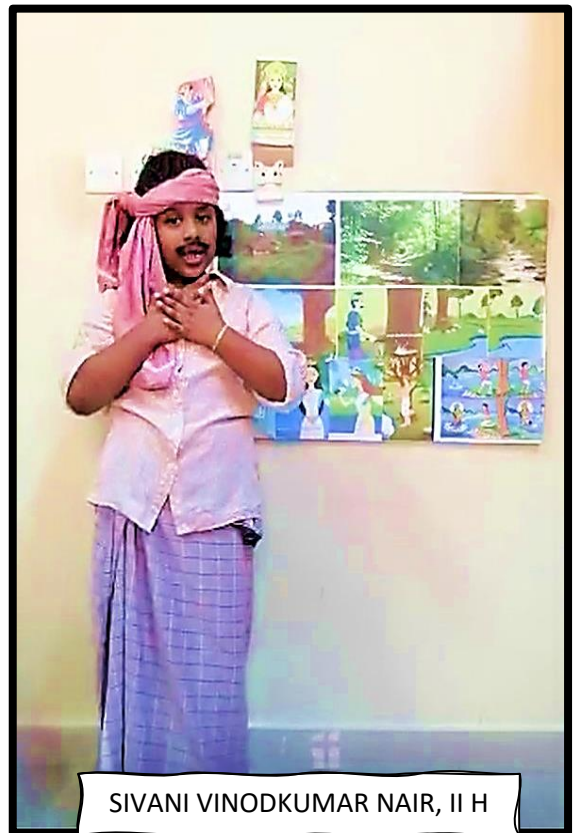
