Time to upload your drawing: 10.15 a.m. to 11 a.m.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

* Content *Tools used *Aesthetics (color choice and presentation) Other Rules and Regulations:

- 1. The file submitted by the student MUST BE the WORK OF THE STUDENT ONLY and NO ALTERATIONS must be done by any other person other than the student. If found that the work has been duplicated/downloaded from the internet/ not of the student's own creation, the entry will be disqualified.
- 2. During the competition, the teacher may ask any of the students to share their screen and check the work in progress. In case the student fails to show the work in progress, the student's entry will be disqualified.
- 3. Only one file can be uploaded as the entry for the competition.
- 4. The work should be based on the given topic in the given file formats.
- 5. In case of any hardware issues, the student should inform his/her computer teacher through mail well in advance.
- 6. The judge's decision is final.

Please note that it will be <u>mandatory</u> for all students to participate in the Tux Paint drawing competition.

THE WORK MUST BE UPLOADED IN THE GOOGLE CLASSROOM, THE UPLOADED WORK MUST BE IN THE FORM OF .jpg / .png /.pdf
