(2 DECEMBER 2018)




In India, National Pollution Prevention Day is observed every year on 2nd December. It is observed in the memory of those who have lost their lives in the Bhopal Gas tragedy on 2nd December, 1984. Indians are

drowning, choking and gasping in a miasma of pollution. So the main objective of it is to make people aware and spread awareness that cause various pollution like water, air, soil, noise and affect the environment and obviously health.

2nd December 2018 was the day on which Class IV students of Indian School Al Wadi Al Kabir Primary Wing observed Pollution Prevention Day.

A Special Assembly was conducted by the students of Class IV A. Students from IV-A to IV-J (Morning Shift) with their class teachers were present at the event. The programme begin with an introduction about the importance of this day. A short video was played to draw the



attention of the students towards the campaign to save our environment. It was followed by cultural programmes – A Qawalli on the types and preventive measures of pollution and a dance number with a jist – “SAY NO TO PLASTIC”. Beautifully colored and decorated candle holders made with old newspapers were presented to all the teachers as a token of remembrance.

Mrs. Ambika Padmanabhan, Academic Co-ordinator-EVS, graced the occasion with her presence and the programme ended with her enriching talk on pollution which reminded students about their duties towards the environment.

In the Afternoon Shift, a special PA assembly was conducted by the students urging people to adopt eco-friendly lifestyle and save trees to reduce the impact of pollution. They also stressed on waste management and recycling to keep our neighbourhood clean.

To reinforce these values, students made exhibits of a dust bin and a garden decor made out of plastic bottles and was kept for display in the foyer.

Students of class IV made banners on 4 R's (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle and Replace) and went on a Procession within the school campus to explain the importance of 4 R's in reducing the pollution prevention.
