

## EID AL-ADHA

### SPECIAL ASSEMBLY

Eid al-Adha, known as the Feast of Sacrifice or the Greater Eid, is one of the two most important celebrations in the Muslim calendar.

Eid also marks the end of Hajj, the five-day religious journey that takes Muslims to the Grand Mosque in Mecca, Saudi Arabia. Although only pilgrims in Mecca participate in the Hajj fully, Muslims around the world join them in celebrating Eid Al – Adha.

A special Assembly was conducted on the 8<sup>th</sup> of August 2019, at Indian School Al Wadi Al Kabir Primary Wing (Morning shift) by the students of classes I C ,II E, III E ,V C and V H to mark the occasion.

The students presented a skit on the performance of Hajj rituals (Tawaff) , and the importance of giving charity to help the poor and spreading happiness. Eid celebration was followed by melodious Eid songs depicting the celebration and festivity on the day of Eid followed by a joyful dance and distribution of various sweets prepared during Eid.
