The Counselling and Special Education Department of the primary conducted an awareness program on “Academic difficulties faced by Children” on 5th November 2016.

The aim of the program was to create awareness among parents for the academic and behavioural challenges faced by students. The program also focused on the importance of early intervention to prevent children from going into further or secondary difficulties

The school Counsellor Mrs.Rajitha Joby, a Psychologist and registered Special Educator by profession, delivered a session on “Reasons for Academic and Behavioural Problems among Children”.

The primary school Counsellor Mrs.Metty Rubin, a Medical & Psychiatric social worker by profession, highlighted areas of the School counselling process and the assistance offered to students who needed special support.

The Special Educator of the Primary wing, Mrs.Rashmi Joshi detailed areas related to “Types of Learning disorders (LD) and Symptoms”.

The Guest Counsellor Mrs. Rohini Swaminathan, who is a Child and Family welfare Social worker explained how parents could help their children.

The program offered a platform for the parents to interact with the Counsellors and Special Educators and to know about the techniques that can be applied to help their children with academic and behavioural concerns.
