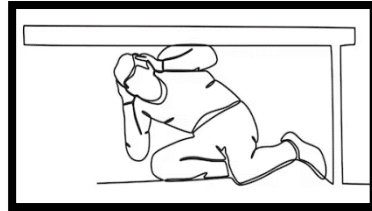




**I. Pick out the Prepositions from the short story given below and write them in the place provided.**
