PARAGRAPH WRITING

A paragraph is a group of sentences related to a single topic.



A paragraph must be:

- **well-developed**-the main argument of a paragraph must be structured in a comprehensive and logical way.
- **unified**-the central idea of a paragraph introduced through the topic sentence must be followed up with supporting sentences, leading to the concluding sentence at the end of it.
- **coherent**--all the sentences in a paragraph must be well-coordinated to establish the central idea of the paragraph in an appropriate manner. Each sentence must naturally lead to the other till the end.
- **well-organized**-points regarding the central theme must be ordered according to their importance and merit.

Types of Paragraphs:

It is essential to know the types of paragraph writing before you write about any given topic.


Descriptive: This kind of writing basically describes the topic and appeals to the five senses.

Narrative: These kinds of writing are basically a narration of a story or a situation that includes a sequence.

Expository: These kinds of writing are a definition of something. These paragraphs require a lot of research.

Persuasive: These kinds of writing aim to make the audience admit a


writer's point of view. These are mostly used by the teachers to provide a strong argument.







How to write a good paragraph:

- 1. Brainstorm what you know about the topic.
- 2. Choose the topic sentence: what is this paragraph going to mostly be about?
- 3. Write details to add more information about the topic. (Examples: Reasons to support an opinion, facts, or events in a story)
- 4. Choose a closing sentence to wrap up your paragraph.
- 5. Re-read your paragraph to make sure it makes sense.







Sample Paragraph
