**Reflexive pronouns** are words like **myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, yourselves and themselves**. They refer back to the person or thing within the same sentence.



For example – I was looking at **myself** in the mirror.

Reflexive pronouns are used to turn the action done by the subject of a sentence, back to the subject. Reflexive pronouns are used when the subject and object is the same person or thing.



It usually ends with '**self**' or '**selves**'.

For example - My mother bought a bag for **herself** on her birthday.

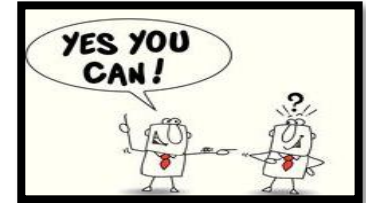
**Singular Reflexive Pronouns**
