Reflexive pronouns are words like myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, yourselves and **themselves**. They refer back to the person or thing within the same sentence.

For example – I was looking at **myself** in the mirror.



Reflexive pronouns are used to turn the

action done by the subject of a sentence, back to the subject.

Reflexive pronouns are used when the subject and object is the

same person or thing.

It usually ends with 'self' or 'selves'.

For example - My mother bought a bag for **herself** on her birthday.
