

TENSES

Tenses play a crucial role in the English language. It denotes the time an action takes place, whether sometime in the past, in the present or will take place sometime in the future.

The form of the verb changes with the number of the subject and time expressed in the sentence. The three basic times expressed by the verb are:

(i) The Present; (ii) The Past and (iii) The Future.



Tense	Formation
Present Simple	Subject + Verb (PRESENT/V1)
Present Continuous	Subject + is/am/are + Verb-ing
Past Simple	Subject + Verb (PAST/V2)
Past Continuous	Subject + was/were + Verb-ing
Future Simple	Subject + will + Verb (PRESENT/V1)
Future Continuous	Subject + will be + Verb-ing
Present Perfect	Subject + has/ have + Verb (PAST PARTICIPLE/V3)
Past Perfect	Subject + had + Verb (PAST PARTICIPLE/V3)
Future Perfect	Subject + will have + Verb (PAST PARTICIPLE/V3)
