**A good story has five important elements:**

<p><b>Characters</b> They are the people ,animals or objects in the story.</p>	<p><b>Setting</b> <b>Eg:</b> garden, forest, room,desert,riverside <b>Time:</b> morning,evening,night.</p>
<p><b>Conflict</b> is the problem or challenge that the characters face in the story. It helps to create tension and suspense in the story.</p>	<p><b>Solution</b>-It represents the nature of things that resolve the problem.</p>

**Theme:** The underlying message or lesson that the story conveys.

**Remember :**

- 1.The story should always be written in the past tense.
- 2.Sequencing of the events in the correct order is important.
3. Check for the spelling and grammatical errors.
4. Check for proper use of Punctuation Marks.
5. Don't forget to write the closing sentence.
