Crocodiles are reptiles like snakes or lizards. They are found all over the world. Crocodiles live in rivers, lakes and wetlands in warm parts of the world.

Crocodiles have long snouts; sharp teeth and they are very good hunters. They have excellent eyesight. This allows them to see at night and to see while swimming under the water. Crocodiles also have good hearing.

Many people confuse the crocodile with the alligator. The crocodile has a v-shaped snout while the alligator has a shorter u-shaped snout. Also, when the alligator's mouth is shut, all its teeth are hidden. But, when the crocodile's mouth is shut, you can see some of its teeth.

Crocodiles eat almost anything including fish, water buffalo, deer and even humans. They don't chew their food. Instead, they tear off big chunks of flesh and swallow it whole.

Crocodiles are good mothers to their babies and they protect them until they are old enough to look after themselves. Crocodiles are excellent swimmers. They can stay underwater for up to an hour. Never enter the water if you see a sign for crocodiles!
