

Subtraction

Taking one number away from another number or taking away things from a collection is called subtraction.

a. Here are 5 mangoes.




We take away 2 mangoes.

3 mangoes are left.

So, $5 - 2 = 3$

b. Sia brought 6 balloons.



She gave 4 balloons to her sister.

2 balloons are left

So, $6 - 4 = 2$



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


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
