Adjectives – Adjectives are words that describe other words. Verbs – Verbs are words that show action. Adverbs – Adverbs are words that add meaning to verbs, adjectives, or other adverbs. Preposition – A preposition is a word palace before a noun or pronoun. Conjunction – A conjunction is a word that connects two words, phrases, or clauses. Interjection – A word used to communicate emotion is called an interjection.


