PARTS OF SPEECH

Parts of speech are the basic categories that words belong to, based on how they function in a sentence. In English, the main ones are:



Part of Speech	Definition	Example
Noun	A word that names a person, place, thing, or idea.	<i>Leo</i> runs fast.
Pronoun	A word that replaces a noun to avoid repetition.	<i>She</i> is my friend.
Adjective	A word that describes or gives more information about a noun.	The <i>blue</i> sky is clear.
Verb	A word that shows action or a state of being.	Birds <i>fly</i> .
Adverb	A word that describes a verb, adjective, or another adverb.	He runs <i>quickly</i> .
Preposition	A word that shows the relationship between a noun/pronoun and another word.	The book is <i>on</i> the table.
Conjunction	A word that joins words, phrases, or sentences.	I like tea <i>and</i> coffee.
Interjection	A word that expresses sudden feeling or emotion.	<i>Wow!</i> That's amazing.
