Nouns are naming words. There are different kinds of nouns.













A **Proper Noun** is the name of a particular person, place, animal or thing. They always start with a capital letter.

A **Common Noun** is the same name given to persons, places, things or animals.

Eg. boy, mall, pencil, dog
