Adjectives of Number include.....

Cardinal Numbers - one, two three and so on. **Ordinal Numbers**- first, second, third and so on.

Adjectives of Number are used to describe Countable Nouns.

Few, some, many, all, several and **no** are also used as Adjectives of number when they are used with **Countable Nouns**.

- **E.g.**1. There are **some** apples in the basket.
 - 2. There are **many** children in the park.
 - 3. There are **several** flowers in the bouquet.

Here **some, many** and **several** are Adjectives of Number as, apples, children and flowers are Countable Nouns.
