Conjunctions are words that join other words, phrases or sentences together. They are an important part of speech.

Conjunction	Relationship	Example
1. since	It is used to give a reason for something in a sentence.	I decided to stay indoors since it was raining.
2. for	It is used to show an intention/purpose for something.	He went to the store, for he needed to buy some medicines.
3. yet	It is used to indicate that an event only happens up to a certain point in time.	The weather was very cold, yet we played outside.
4. though	It is used to show contrast in a sentence.	Though I don't drink coffee, I have had two cups today.
5. unless	It is used to say what follows a certain happening.	You won't succeed unless you work hard.
6. although	It is used to show contrast in a sentence.	Although she was ill, she went to work.



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
