Conjunction	Relationship	Example
1. since	It is used to give a reason for something in a sentence.	We couldn't go swimming <b>since</b> the pool was closed.
2. for	It is used to show an intention/purpose for something.	I wore my jacket, <b>for</b> it was very cold outside.
3. yet	It is used to indicate that an event only happens up to a certain point in time.	It was raining, <b>yet</b> we played outside.
