What is an Abstract Noun?

An 'Abstract Noun' is a word that names emotions, feelings, ideas or concepts. In simple terms, nouns that cannot be physically experienced by our five senses are Abstract Nouns. They are the opposite of **concrete nouns**.

Eg: beauty, happiness, childhood, kindness.

Abstract Nouns are formed by adding a suffix to nouns, verbs, or adjectives.
