Definition:

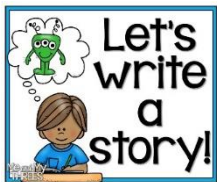
- ✓ A Story is a work of fiction or imagination that is usually written in easily understandable grammatical structure with natural flow of speech.
- ✓ Story writing is an art. It is the oldest form of written composition.
- ✓ It is a work of imagination that is written in an easily understandable grammatical structure.



POINTS TO REMEMBER:

Give a suitable title and it should be as short as possible.

- ✓ Introduce the main character and setting (time and location) in the beginning.
- ✓ Develop suspense and action through a sequence of events in chronological order (with a clear beginning, middle and end).
- ✓ Provide a suitable moral in the end.
- ✓ Use past tense while writing the story.

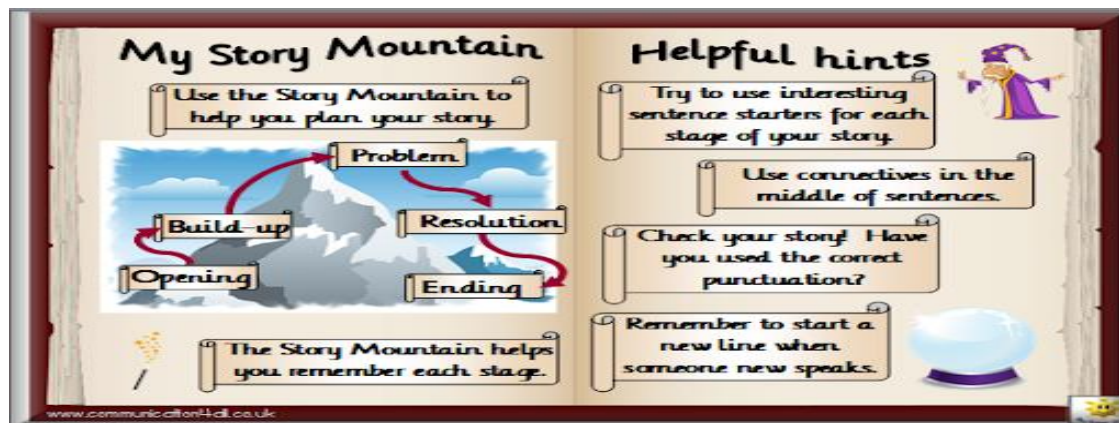
- **The introduction or beginning of the story** (set up the action/plot, gives background of the story or builds in a way that grabs the attention.)
