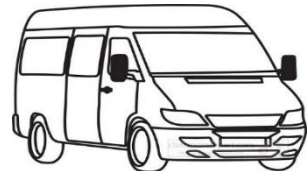
- b. You are planning to visit a friend in another country, and you want to get there faster. The different means of transport you could use to travel internationally are by airplane and ship.
