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SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

Every complete sentence contains two parts: a **Subject and** a **Predicate**. The **Subject** is what (or whom) the sentence is about, while the **Predicate** tells something about the subject. In a sentence the person, animal or thing is the **Subject**.

The Subject consists of all the words that tell, whom or what a sentence is about. (noun or pronoun)

Eg: The boys are playing cricket.

The ferocious dog barks at strangers.

The clock tells us the time.

The Predicate (verb) consists of the verb and all the words that describe the verb and complete the meaning.

Eg: The old man walks with a stick.

The lion is the king of the jungle.

The stars twinkle in the night sky.
