Ans: Alink is for active link while vlink is for visited link. When a hyperlink becomes active, i.e., when the mouse cursor moves over it, its colour will become as specified in alink attribute. And when a hyperlink is clicked, its colour changes to the colour as specified in vlink attribute. As per above code, active hyperlink will show in red and once visited, it will be of yellow colour.
