7. What is the difference between basefont and font tag?

Answer: <BASEFONT> tag defines the default font, size, and color for the whole text in an HTML document.

<FONT> tag is used to define font, size, and color for a text enclosed within the <FONT> tag. To apply the effect of <FONT>, you need to enclose the text within the font tag. 8. How can a 2D or 3D horizontal rule be displayed?

Answer: <HR size = 20 noshade> HR tag with noshade attribute is used to make 2D rule.<HR size = 20> HR tag without noshade attribute is used to make 3D rule.

9. How can different tags be combined in HTML? What is its use?

Answer: In HTML, you can combine different tags together. Outer tags closed after the inner tags. It is used to customized the appearance of text as per your requirements.

For example: <P> Hi this text is in <font color=blue> Blue Color </font>
