PREFIX

Prefix is a letter or a group of letters added to the beginning of a word or a root word to make a new word with a different meaning.

Eg: im + possible =impossible (prefix) (root word)

The word "impossible" consists of the prefix 'im' which means not, combined with the root word 'possible'. The new word 'impossible' means not possible.

REMEMBER

*Most of the words change to their antonyms (opposite) when the Prefixes are added.

Eg: in +visible + invisible , mis +understand = misunderstand

*The meaning of the word changes when a Prefix is added.

* A prefix can be a single letter too.

Eg: **a**sleep, **a**wake

Some examples of Prefixes

| Prefix | Meaning | Example |
|--------|---------------|--|
| il- | not | illogical, illegal, illiterate |
| im- | not, without | imperfect, impossible, immature |
| in- | not, without | incorrect, invisible, incorrigible |
| mis- | wrong, bad | misbehave, misunderstand, misfortune |
| dis- | not, opposite | disrespect, disappear, disappoint |
| un- | not, against | unknown, unfriendly, undone |
| re- | again | redo react renew |
| ir- | not | irregular irresponsible irresistible |
