SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

A sentence has two parts:

- a. subject
- b. predicate

Example: Rahul likes playing football.

- 'Rahul' is the SUBJECT because the sentence is about 'Rahul'.
- 'likes playing football' is the PREDICATE because it tells us about the subject 'Rahul'.

Subject- The Subject consists of all the words that tell, whom or what a sentence is about. (noun or pronoun)

Example: The boy was chasing a cat.
The helicopter flew over the sea.

Predicate- The Predicate (verb) consists of the verb and all the words that describe the verb and complete the meaning.

Example: The toy car was running on the track.
Suraj is sleeping.



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
