Q.1. Answer these questions in short:

1. What did Rama Natha believe?

2. How could Rama Natha have a big banana plantation after six years?

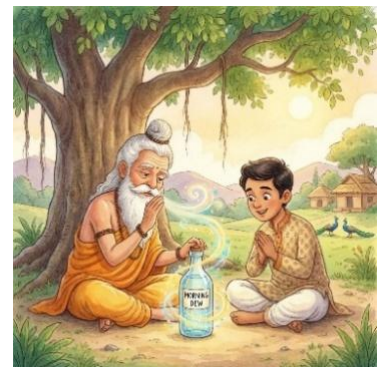
