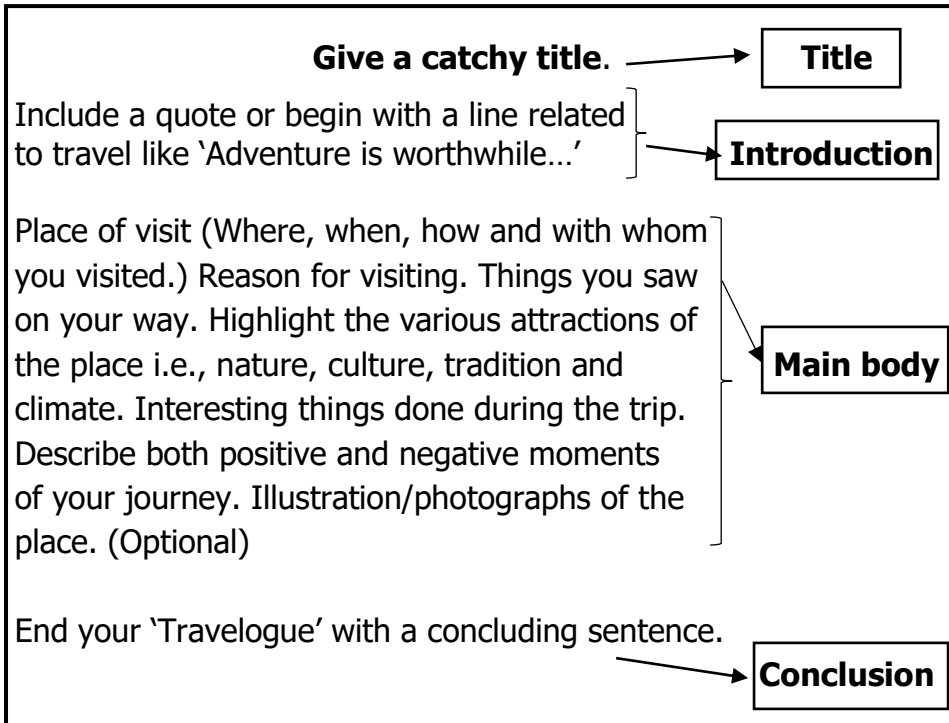

How to write/create a 'Travelogue'?

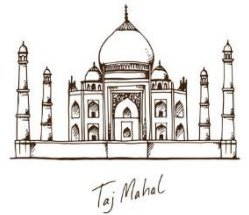
