Capital Letters are used

❖ at the beginning of a sentence

E.g.- The children like to play every day.

❖ for special names

E.g.- Messi, Muscat, September, Red Fort, Pacific Ocean, Bible, Avenue Mall, English

❖ for the pronoun 'I' and words like 'God' and 'Lord'

Punctuation Marks

Full stop or Period (.) - A full stop is used at the end of a sentence that does not ask a question.

E.g.- Lucy lives in Paris.

Question Mark (?)- A question mark is used at the end of a sentence that asks a question.

E.g.- Where do you stay?
