Capital letters are used:

- at the beginning of a sentence.
Eg: Alice goes to the park everyday to play.
- for special names.
Eg. Tom, Muscat, August, Taj Mahal, Indian Ocean, Tinkle, Avenues Mall, English
- for the pronoun 'I' and words like 'God' and 'Lord'.

Punctuation Marks

- Full Stop or Period (.) – A full stop is used at the end of a sentence that does not ask a question.
Eg: Mary likes to eat cake on Fridays.
- Question Mark (?) – A question mark is used at the end of a sentence that asks a question.
Eg: Do you want hot cocoa?
