Countable Nouns

- ✓ They are nouns that **can be** counted.
- \checkmark They have singular and plural forms.
- ✓ The articles **'a' or 'an'** can be used for singular countable nouns.

Uncountable Nouns

- ✓ They are nouns that **cannot be** counted.
- ✓ We **do not** use the article **`a' or `an'** with them.
- ✓ We use **quantifiers** like **some**, **little** or **much** before them.
- \checkmark For example: a little salt, some juice, or much food.
- \checkmark They do not have a plural form.

Note:

We can use **measure words** or **counters** to quantify Uncountable Nouns. For example:

- a glass of water
- a bowl of soup
- **a pinch** of salt
- a slice of bread ٠
